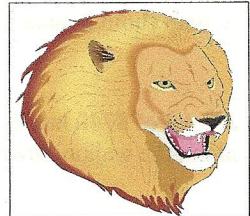

1. Mission to Mexico has been postponed because of the border unrest.
2. State dues will increase by \$4 in the next two years.
3. The Youth Exchange Program is looking for sponsor families.
4. The District Convention will again feature information booths from clubs.

### CORRESPONDENCE

1. A letter was received from the IR Elementary PTO requested a \$200 donation for basketball pole posts. It was approved.
2. A thank you from the Western Bayfield County Historical Society for our \$200 donation. IR Lions will have a historical display.
3. The Northwestern High School Drama & Music Department requested a donation to their musical. We voted to donate \$100.
4. Scott Eisenhauer requested \$200 to pay for his attendance at a National Traffic Highway Association Standardized Child Passenger Safety Certification Training. It was approved.
5. The American Youth Soccer Organization requested that all the Lions clubs in the Northwestern School District donate \$100 to a Lions Club Playership Fund. It was approved and a suggestion for adding it to next years budget.
6. Last month a request was made for an eye exam from a local resident at a sum of \$50, she now needs glasses, Tess Eisenhauer volunteered to look into the cost of those. A cape of \$200 was put on this.
